

UKYP STAFF

The best way to think about UKYP staff is as civil servants. Like the civil service in Westminster, UKYP staff are employed to carry out the practical and administrative work of the organisation and to support the work of MYPs.

THE CENTRAL TEAM

Led by the Chief Executive, Andy Hamflett, the Central Team perform a range of functions. Amongst other things, they are responsible for regional and national fundraising, developing new opportunities for MYPs, managing the organisation's finances, working with PG Reps to organise the Annual Sitting, liaising with Government departments, responding to enquiries from the general public and maintaining the UKYP website and e-groups.

They also carry out the day-to-day dull jobs such as photocopying, envelope stuffing and filing!

REGIONAL CO-ORDINATORS

The work in each of the nine English regions and three devolved nations is overseen by a Regional Co-ordinator, whose time commitment is dictated by funding available in each area. Regional Co-ordinators also perform a range of functions.

They organise regional meetings, support MYPs and DMYPs to develop projects and events, liaise with LAs to ensure they participate in UKYP, develop relationships with other regional organisations and much more besides!

Ultimately the role of UKYP staff is to work with, and support, MYPs, DMYPs, PG Reps and Trustees to develop and improve the UK Youth Parliament.
