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## Introduction

On the 10th November 2017 Members of the UK Youth Parliament (UKYP) will come together to debate and decide at the UKYP House of Commons sitting the most important issues to campaign on for the year ahead. The sitting will mark the launch of Parliament Week. The issues they will debate were decided upon via the 'Make Your Mark' public vote for 11 to 18 year olds across the United Kingdom based on a shortlist of topics voted upon by Members of the Youth Parliament from their manifesto.

This report details the results of 'Make Your Mark' campaign. The UK Youth Parliament is managed by the British Youth Council, a youth-led charity which aims to empower young people across the UK to have a say and be heard.

Every year the UK Youth Parliament holds a UK-wide ballot called 'Make Your Mark', where all young people can vote on what they think Members of the Youth Parliament should campaign on for the year ahead.

**Note FINAL NUMBERS:** Whilst every effort is made to verify the accuracy of voting returns at the time of going to print, there are some late returns and unallocated votes that have not been recorded in this first edition of the report.

## The five issues to be debated

The Make Your Mark ballot orders the top five issues, but those chosen for the UK wide priorities debate must include 2 UK wide topics and 3 reserved English only topics. Due to the devolved nature of the UK democracy and to ensure relevant representation of the issues from the all nations.

### 1. A Curriculum to prepare us for life

**Schools should cover topics including finance, sex and relationships and politics in the curriculum.** (England only topic)

### 2. Transport

**Make public transport cheaper, better and accessible for all.** (England only topic)

### 3. Work Experience hubs for 11-18 year olds

**Knowing where to find work experience can be challenging. Government should create an online space to help young people with this.** (England only topic)

### 4. Votes at 16

**Give 16 and 17 year olds the right to vote in all elections/referendums.** (UK wide topic)

### 5. Protect LGBT+ People

**Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender+ young people deserve to be treated the same as everyone else; discrimination needs to be challenged.** (UK wide topic)
