Introduction

On the 23rd November 2012 Members of the UK Youth Parliament (UKYP) will come together to debate and decide at the UKYP House of Commons sitting the most important issue to campaign on for the year ahead. The issues they will debate were decided upon via the 'Make your Mark' public vote of 11 to 18 year olds across the United Kingdom. This report details the results of 'Make Your Mark'. The UK Youth Parliament is managed by the British Youth Council, a youth-led charity which aims to empower young people across the UK to have a say and be heard. Every year the UKYP holds a UK-wide ballot called 'Make Your Mark', where all young people can vote on what they think Members of the Youth Parliament should campaign on for the year ahead
